Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival and Pickup from Entebbe International Airport to Your Hotel, City tour if time Allows

Welcome to Uganda, the Pearl of Africa, and the beginning of your unforgettable safari adventure. Situated on the northern shores of Lake Victoria, the world's second largest freshwater lake, nearby Entebbe is renowned for its lush greenery, relaxed atmosphere, excellent lakeside restaurants, and outstanding birdlife, making it one of the most charming gateway cities in Africa.

Day 2: Transfer to Murchison Falls National Park via Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary

After an early breakfast, your driver guide will pick you up from your hotel in Kampala and begin the journey to Murchison Falls National Park, Uganda's largest and most spectacular protected area. Along the way, you will stop at Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary for an exciting guided rhino tracking experience, offering a rare opportunity to observe Uganda's only wild rhinos in their natural habitat while learning about ongoing conservation efforts to protect these endangered animals. After the tracking experience, continue to Murchison Falls National Park and arrive in time for lunch at your lodge. In the afternoon, you may choose to enjoy a guided nature walk around the lodge, where you can spot a variety of bird species, monkeys, and other wildlife, or visit the top of the magnificent Murchison Falls. Here, witness the mighty River Nile force its way through a narrow gorge before plunging dramatically into the valley below, creating one of the most powerful and breathtaking waterfalls in Africa. Later, return to your lodge for dinner and an overnight stay surrounded by the beauty and wilderness of Murchison Falls National Park.

Day 3: Early Morning Game Drive and Boat Trip on the Nile

After breakfast, set out for an exciting morning game drive through the vast savannah plains of Murchison Falls National Park, home to an incredible diversity of wildlife. As you explore the park's scenic landscapes, look out for elephants, lions, leopards, buffaloes, Rothschild's giraffes, antelopes, warthogs, and many other fascinating species that inhabit this remarkable ecosystem. Following the safari, return to Paraa Safari Lodge for lunch and relaxation while enjoying the beautiful surroundings. Along the way, observe large pods of hippos, Nile crocodiles basking on the riverbanks, and an abundance of water birds that thrive in this rich aquatic habitat. As you approach the falls, witness the dramatic sight of the Nile's powerful waters crashing through a narrow gorge before plunging into the river below. After this unforgettable experience, return to Paraa Safari Lodge for dinner and an overnight stay within the heart of Murchison Falls National Park.

Day 4: Transfer to Kibale National Park the Primates Capital of the World

After an early breakfast, depart for Kibale National Park, enjoying a scenic drive of approximately five hours through Uganda's beautiful countryside. The journey takes you past rolling hills, lush green forests, rural villages, and expansive tea plantations, offering a rich glimpse into local life and the country's stunning landscapes. Upon arrival, check in at Chimpundu Lodge, a luxury accommodation set in a tranquil natural environment with spacious rooms and breathtaking views. Kibale National Park is renowned for its large population of around one thousand chimpanzees, making it one of the best places in Africa for primate viewing. The park is also home to a remarkable variety of other primates, including the rare Uganda mangabey, as well as over three hundred and seventy bird species such as the vibrant great blue turaco and the elusive green breasted pitta. Perfectly positioned on the edge of the forest without fences, Chimpundu Lodge offers an ideal base for exploring this incredible destination.

Day 5: Day for Chimpanzee Trekking and Bigodi Swamp Walk

Renowned for its exceptional primate diversity, the park offers one of the best opportunities in Africa to observe chimpanzees in their natural habitat, with thousands of individuals living within its rich rainforest ecosystem. Accompanied by an experienced ranger guide, venture into the forest in search of a chimpanzee group, while also having the chance to encounter other primates along the way. Queen Elizabeth National Park is famous for its incredible variety of wildlife, including elephants, lions, leopards, buffaloes, Uganda kobs, waterbucks, hippos, and warthogs, as well as the rare tree climbing lions found in the Ishasha sector. The park is also a paradise for bird lovers, with over six hundred recorded species such as African spoonbills, pied kingfishers, fish eagles, pelicans, and vultures. In the afternoon, relax at the lodge before heading out for an evening game drive, where you may encounter large herds of elephants, predators resting in the shade, and other wildlife emerging as the day cools. Later, return to Mweya Safari Lodge for dinner and an overnight stay within the heart of Queen Elizabeth National Park.

Day 7: Early Morning Game Drive and Afternoon Boat Exercursion on Kazinga Channel

After the boat safari, return to Mweya Safari Lodge and take in the breathtaking views over the Kazinga Channel while unwinding in the comfort of your surroundings. Dinner and overnight will be at Mweya Safari Lodge inside Queen Elizabeth National Park.

Day 8: Transfer to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Your day begins with a delicious breakfast before setting out for a morning game drive across Queen Elizabeth National Park. After the game drive, continue your journey to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park, traveling through scenic countryside, rolling hills, and rural settlements along the way. Upon arrival, check in at Four Gorillas Lodge, a comfortable retreat set within the lush forest surroundings. Known for its steep forested hills and exceptional biodiversity, Bwindi Impenetrable National Park is home to nearly half of the world's remaining mountain gorillas, making it one of the most important conservation areas in Africa. A visit here offers one of the most extraordinary wildlife experiences on the continent, as you prepare for the unforgettable encounter with these gentle giants in their natural habitat. Spend the rest of the day relaxing at Four Gorillas Lodge, enjoying its warm hospitality and tranquil forest atmosphere. Dinner and overnight will be at the lodge inside Bwindi Impenetrable National Park.

Day 9: Gorilla Trekking at Bwindi and Batwa Cultural Experience

This extraordinary adventure offers a rare opportunity to encounter one of the world's most endangered species, the mountain gorilla, in its natural rainforest habitat. Bwindi is home to nearly half of the remaining mountain gorilla population, making it one of the most significant conservation areas in Africa. The park also supports a remarkable diversity of wildlife, including several primate species, mammals, butterflies, and hundreds of bird species. Accompanied by experienced ranger guides, you will trek through dense forest terrain in search of a habituated gorilla family. The trek may take several hours depending on their location, but once found, you will spend up to one hour observing their behavior, interactions, and family dynamics in a truly emotional and awe inspiring encounter. After the experience, return to Four Gorillas Lodge for lunch and relaxation, followed by a cultural visit to the Batwa community to learn about their traditional forest life and heritage. Later, enjoy dinner and another overnight stay at Four Gorillas Lodge inside Bwindi Impenetrable National Park.

Day 10: Transfer to Lake Bunyonyi For Relaxation Experience

After breakfast, depart Bwindi and travel to the stunning Lake Bunyonyi, one of Uganda's most beautiful and peaceful destinations. Known as the "Place of Little Birds," this scenic lake is surrounded by rolling terraced hills and dotted with numerous islands, offering a truly idyllic retreat. It is also one of the few lakes in Uganda that is safe for swimming, as it is free of hippos and crocodiles, making it ideal for relaxation after your gorilla trekking experience. Upon arrival, check in at Arcadia Lodge Lake Bunyonyi, a charming ridgetop lodge offering breathtaking panoramic views over the lake and its many islands. The lodge features beautifully maintained gardens and comfortable cottages designed with natural materials that blend harmoniously with the surrounding environment. In the afternoon, choose between a relaxing sundowner experience overlooking the lake or a scenic boat trip exploring the fascinating islands of this remarkable, second deepest lake in Africa. Dinner and overnight will be at Arcadia Lodge Lake Bunyonyi.

Day 12: Transfer to Lake Mburo National Park

The park is home to a rich variety of wildlife, including hippos in the lakes, buffaloes along the shores, leopards roaming at night, and abundant plains grazers such as zebras, impalas, and the rare Rothschild's giraffes. It also supports a remarkable diversity of birdlife, especially species associated with aquatic and acacia habitats that are not commonly found elsewhere in the country. Once Uganda's second largest city, Jinja is known for its rich colonial heritage, charming architecture, and scenic location along the shores of Lake Victoria at the source of the Nile. En route, you will stop in Kampala for lunch before continuing the drive to your unique accommodation at Wildwaters Lemala Lodge. Upon arrival, check in and take time to relax while enjoying the exceptional natural surroundings and river views that define this remarkable property. In the evening, enjoy dinner at the lodge and settle in for an overnight stay at Wildwaters Lodge, perfectly positioned to offer a peaceful retreat surrounded by the flowing waters of the River Nile.

After the rafting adventure, return to Wildwaters Lodge for a hot lunch and some time to relax in the peaceful riverside setting. Later, check out and begin your journey back to Kampala City. As your Ugandan safari comes to an end, reflect on the unforgettable experiences, breathtaking landscapes, and incredible wildlife encounters that have made this journey truly special.
